## **BREAKING IT DOWN**



Giving worth to God was exactly what the wise men did in the verses you just read in Matthew chapter 2. They went looking for the King of the Jews, which is Jesus, and when they found Him they bowed down and worshipped Him. Then they opened their treasures and presented Him with gifts. They gave **WORTH** to Jesus by bowing down to Him and bringing gifts to Him. That was how much Jesus was worth to the wise men. How much is Jesus worth to you?



## **BREAKING IT DOWN**

Read Matthew 2:1-2 and 2:10-11

What is worship? Well the best way to tell you about worship is to tell you about a baseball card I have. It's a very valuable card. In fact, you may say it's worth alot! It's worth some money but more importantly it has sentimental value to me. Sentimental value means that I have had it for a pretty long time. When I look at this card it reminds me of when I played little league and all the friends I used to play baseball with. So it's valuable to me because it's worth some money and has sentimental worth for me as well. I have this card in a protective case for everyone to see. I keep it protected because I don't want it to be damaged. I don't treat it like some other cards I have. I have other cards that are often referred to as common cards, cards that really aren't worth very much. I keep these cards in a box in the garage because they are not worth very much to me.

Believe it or not our worship to God is kind of like that baseball card. In fact maybe for just a minute we can change the name from worship to "WORTH SHIP," because whenever we worship God we are saying he is valuable to us. We are saying God is WORTH something to us. Just like my baseball card. We should hold God up for everyone to see. We should protect our relationship with him so it won't be damaged. We certainly don't want to put our relationship with God out in the garage with all of the other common relationships we have with friends. The Bible says that we should put our relationship with God ahead of all other relationships!
