1. Video Question from man on the street.
Question: What are facts? Are facts important? Can you tell me a fact?
2. Try some facts:
Fact: If I drop this apple it's a fact...it will fall.
Fact: If I pour this pitcher of water out on Cynthia's head it's a fact...she will get wet.
Fact: If I jump off this chair it's a fact...I will hit the ground.

A fact does not change... a fact, is fact, is a fact!

X-cursion: (Story)

Tell a story about how the facts got messed up, and you almost got in trouble. (Ex. TPing a house).

X-cuse: (Reasons why I don't believe what you said)

You may be saying: "I am at camp to have fun and that's it."

The FACT is...God may have other plans for you.

X-cept: (Object Lesson & Verse)

Toilet Paper (24 roles, Broom, plunger stick)

X-pect: (Verse and Thought)

We are going to be talking about being X-isled for God. The verses we are using are in 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 which says, *Don't you know that your body is a temple that belongs to the Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit, whom you received from God, lives in you. You don't belong to yourselves. You were bought for a price. So bring glory to God in the way you use your body.*

Bible verse:

Don't you know that your body is a temple that belongs to the Holy Spirit?

1 Corinthians 6:19-20a GWT

Hand motions:

Don't you know that your body (Arms across your chest like you are hugging yourself)
is a temple (Both hands above your head like your making an "A" above your head)
that belongs to the Holy Spirit (Right finger up in the air in a twirling motion)

X-isle means living apart from the rest and that's what God wants us to focus on this week.
